1. Call to Order by Chairperson Followed by a Moment of Silence and the Pledge of Allegiance: **Chairperson Schuler called the meeting to order with the time being 6pm**
2. Roll Call: **Roll Call Showed all members present: Chairperson Schuler, Supervisors Brown, Moesch, Schultz and Zuhse, as well as Treasurer Davis, Zoning Coordinator Moede and Clerk Vreeke. Also present in the audience were 7 electors.**

5. Approve November 17, 2016 Public Hearing & Special Town Meeting Minutes: **Motion to approve November 17, 2016 Public Hearing and Special Town Meeting Minutes made by Melissa Schuler, seconded by Donald Anker. Motion carried with unanimous approval. 7 ayes, 0 naves**
6. Financial Report: **Chairperson Schuler reviewed the 2016 Financial Report completed by Schenck S.C. Motion to approve Financial Report made by Habeck, seconded by Anker. Motion carried with unanimous approval 7 ayes, 0 naves.**
7. Public Input: **Mr. Anker expressed concern over Deanna Ballingers' house on Old Keshena Road. Mr. Anker is concerned about the lack of siding on the house, explaining he feels the house is an eyesore. The Town Board explained the Town has been in contact with the municipal attorney and since there is no county or town ordinance requiring siding, as long as the house is structurally sound and does not contain vermin, it is unlikely the Town can enforce the changes. Tyler Alberston expressed concern about campers being used/parked permanently around his neighborhood. Zoning Coordinator Moede explained he has been in contact with the municipal attorney and the Plan Commission is meeting next week to discuss wording changes in the ordinance to provide the Town with more enforcement power.**

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- 8. Chairman's Update: **Chairperson Schuler updated the public on 2016, including working with the attorney on ordinance changes, purchasing a new garbage truck and providing garbage/recycling cans to all the residents.**
